



The Nigerian Academy of Engineering is an honour society comprising a number of very senior engineers who are dedicated to the technological development of Nigeria. It recognizes that there are several facets to Nigeria's development, however it proffers its strongly-held view that the nation must adopt a pro-active and statutory means of making Nigeria a technologically driven country in order to accelerate these and other facets of development. In furtherance with one of the objectives of the academy, a Travel Fellowship Grant has been initiated.

The Academy, with support from one of its donors is offering travelling fellowship grants to young Nigerian engineering intellectuals wishing to travel for their post-doctoral in the fields of engineering. The grant is expected to cover round trip ticket and a little stipend for incidentals.

Eligibility Criteria

An eligible candidate for the NAEng ticket grant must be

- Young Nigerian engineering academics who trained locally.
- working in a tertiary institution or research establishment in Nigeria.
- working in an area of research directly relevant to the country.
- ready to return to the country after the period.

Application Procedure

To be considered for the grant, candidates must;

- submit a one or two page programme of research to be carried out.
- include the curriculum vitae.
- recommendation from their employer.
- letter of acceptance from the host institution.

Other conditions

- All applications should reach the office of the Nigerian Academy of Engineering not later than **31st March 2015**, for consideration for 2015 research cycle.
- Candidates will be selected based on (among others) the quality of their research proposal and realistic budgeting.
- Multi-disciplinary proposal would be encouraged.
